Poker Championship Qualifier Prize Pool

For every \$300 in player's prize pool, 1 seat will be awarded to the Grand Falls Poker Championship

All entries will be given one of two heat assignments to be determined by a poker room supervisor. No change in these heats can take place without authorization of a poker room supervisor.

All remaining money that does not equal \$300 will be paid to the highest finishing player that does not win a seat

Any player winning a seat that is already registered for Championship Event will be awarded \$300. Qualifying tournaments will no longer take place if the championship event is sold out.

Qualifying events will be limited to a maximum of 3 tables and 50 total players. At 10 min till 6pm all players currently registered plus anyone in line will determine the number of tables to start.

When registration closes at 6:20pm, any dead stacks will be removed from play if the seat has not been sold.

Grand Falls Poker Championship Additional Rules	
1	Limited registration will be available from 10am February 15th, 2018 through March 3rd, 2018. Late registration will be allowed for heat 1 and 2 for the first 30 min. or until there are 80 players.
2	A maximum of 160 players will be divided into 2 heats as evenly as possible. No heat will have more than 80 players. If there are 80 players or less between both heats, all players will play on Sunday, March 4th @ 11am (No Heats)
3	Each Heat will advance a specific number of players based upon the size of the heat. If the heat has 80-60 total players we will advance 30 players to Sunday. 59-40 players will advance 20 to Sunday, and for less than 40 players we will advance 10.
4	Players in each heat will be notified of how many players will advance for their heat. All tables will be hand for hand 1 elimination away from the advancing number.
5	Chip values accumulated by each player during Day #1 will carry over to day #2. This will be counted and verified by a poker room supervisor and signed by the player
6	The starting blind level on Sunday, March 4, 2018 will be determined by the lowest level of the two heats when they finish. That level will be reset at 30 minutes.

Grand Falls Poker Championship Payout Table

Payouts will reference section 1.2 from approved Grand Falls Tournament Rules for a field of 100 players or less. For more than 100 players this table will be used to calculate the payouts.

All payouts are rounded down to the nearest dollar, with the total difference being added to the first place finisher.
